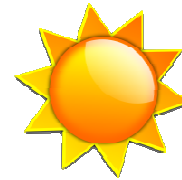
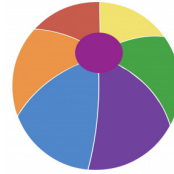
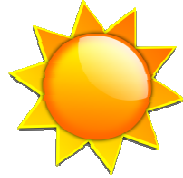

1. All members and their guests must register, have their picture ID checked and pay the proper guest fees prior to entering the pool area.
2. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult and be under adult supervision at all times. Children 12 to 14 years must pass our swim/diving test or be accompanied by an adult.
3. All persons shall obey the instruction of the lifeguards. No person shall use the pool unless it is officially open and the lifeguards are on duty. The pool manager/lifeguards can limit the amount of swimmers in one area where there is a safety concern.
4. Use of the wading pool is limited to children 4 years of age and younger. Parents must accompany and are responsible for the safety of their children while in this area. For non-toilet trained children, swim diapers are required.
5. No diapers of any kind are permitted in the main pool. Children 3 and over who are toilet trained and wish to use the main pool shall be accompanied by a parent/guardian. No swim diapers are permitted in the main pool.
6. The use of floats, water wings or inflated tubes, water toys of any kind are only permitted as follows:
  - a. During the open swim the use of these items will only be permitted when approved by the manager on duty. Approval based on:
    1. Age of child
    2. Adult supervision must be present.
    3. The size and type of floatation device.
    4. The number of swimmers in the pool.
  - b. The manager may prohibit the use of floatation devices at any time if deemed unsafe.
  - c. All floatation devices are prohibited in the deep end.
7. Persons must stay clear of the lifeguard stations at all times. For the safety of all members/guests please do not distract the lifeguards. Please do not step over the black markings around the lifeguard stands.

8. Diving is only permitted in the deep end. The manager will announce when the diving board is open and rules for use will be posted. No one will be allowed to free swim in the deep end when the diving board is in use. Weight limit for the diving board is 235 lbs. No exceptions.
9. Hanging on the safety and lane lines is not permitted. Lap swimmers have the right of way when the lane lines are in place.
10. No running, pushing, wrestling or rough play will be permitted in the pool area. No regular ball playing in the pool area. Unruly behavior will not be permitted.
11. Adult swims will be at the discretion of the manager. All swimmers under the age of 18 must exit the pool for this period.

12. No glass or breakable objects will be permitted in the pool area. No food or beverages are allowed within six feet of the sides of the pool. Small grills are allowed in the pavilion area only with manager approval. Members are expected to dispose of their trash in containers that are provided.
13. No smoking is permitted in the pool and within the pavilion fenced area. No smoking at the entrance of the pool.
14. No pets are permitted in the pool area or grounds.

15. Appropriate swimwear must be worn. No members or guests wearing a thong style suit will be admitted to the pool. The Board reserves the right to restrict and/or decline use of the pool to any member or guest attempting to enter the pool wearing inappropriate or otherwise prohibited swim wear.
16. The lawn furniture is not to be used as play equipment. Members 16 and older have priority use of all lawn furniture. Umbrellas will be opened and closed by staff only, weather permitting. Disinfecting wipes will be available to clean off all furniture before use.
17. All official signs posted by management must be obeyed.
18. Please direct all problems, comments or signed complaints in writing to the Box Hill Office.
19. The Board of Directors has the authority to decide when an infraction of the rules shall result in revocation of any membership.
20. Occasionally the pool will be used for special events. These events will be posted in advance.
21. Alcohol is discouraged, but permitted in small quantities. The manager will ask intoxicated members/guests to leave the pool immediately. Members will not be admitted to the pool with excessive amounts of alcohol. Management reserves the right to inspect all coolers brought into the pool area. You must be 21 years of age or older to drink. **NO GLASS PERMITTED!**
22. The pool manager, at his/her discretion, has the right to remove any member or guest to ensure the safety of all members and employees. Failure to comply will result in suspension/revocation of your membership.
23. Daycare providers must follow COMAR 07.04.01.22. The manager will strictly enforce these rules.
24. Rules and pool hours are subject to change by the Board of Directors at any time.

The pool may be closed for such events as community or private parties. When the pool is to be closed, management will make every effort to post these closings in advance.

### MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

All homeowners, as well as the tenants of homeowners, are eligible for membership providing the assessment account for the unit they own or rent is up-to-date. Membership fees are to be paid in full by the deadline set by the Board. A late fee must be paid to register after the deadline date. A payment plan is offered. Any owner/resident using a payment plan must pay by the deadline set. Otherwise, the balance will be added to your regular HOA dues and your pool membership will be revoked. ***Adding someone to your membership that is not a resident will result in your membership being revoked.*** At any time the Board may request proof of residency and/or proof of age. Pool I.D. picture cards will be taken, cards will be held at the pool office.

### ASSESSMENT DUES & VIOLATIONS

Residents must have all assessments paid up-to-date prior to and during the 2021 pool season and have no outstanding individual violations pending. Residents who fall behind on HOA dues during the pool season may forfeit their remaining pool membership rights for the remainder of the season.

### MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS & FEES

(Children born in 2018 or after will be free)

#### FULL FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

A Family Membership of three consists of one adult and two family members living at the same address. Additional members may be added for an additional fee per person. 1<sup>st</sup> member must be over the age of 18.

- First three members ~ \$425.00
- Additional members ~ \$50.00

#### COUPLE MEMBERSHIP

A Couple Membership is defined as two adults living at the same address or one adult and a dependent child living at the same address. First member must be over the age of 18. No additional members may be added to this membership.

- Per Couple ~ \$325.00

#### INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

Designed for an individual resident 18 years of age or older. No additional members may be added to this membership.

- Per Individual ~ \$225.00

#### JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

Designed for residents 16 or 17 years of age. A parent or guardians signature is required on the application. No additional members may be added to this membership.

- Per Junior ~ \$225.00

#### LIMITED MEMBERSHIP

This membership allows 10 visits any day/time during the pool season. Passes are not transferrable or refundable.

- One Individual resident over 18 ~ \$175.00
- Additional members ~ \$50.00

#### SPONSORSHIP MEMBERSHIP

Designated for a Box Hill Resident to sponsor a family who does not live in Box Hill Community.

- Family Membership (1st Member ~ 21 years or older)
  1. First three members ~ \$475.00
  2. Additional Members ~ \$50.00
- Individual Membership ~ \$275.00
- Couple Membership ~ \$375.00

### DAYCARE CHILDREN

This membership allows members who are licensed daycare providers to bring their daycare children to the pool for a seasonal fee. Children must be non-resident and under the age of 12. Hours are restricted to 12 p.m. ~ 4 p.m. on Monday ~ Friday. Guest fees are charged during evening and weekend hours. Registration forms are available at the barn office. Providers are required to conform to COMAR 07.04.01.22. ***A resident Day Care Provider must have their own Pool Membership.***

- Fee Per Child ~ \$150.00

#### GUEST POLICY

A member must register all guests and the fee must be paid before entering the pool. Members are responsible for the actions of their guest and must be present at all times. Guest fees will not be refunded if they are asked to leave due to unacceptable behavior. A "rain check" will be issued if the pool closes within one hour from the time the guest is registered. Members must be 15 years of age or older to bring a guest. Members wishing to bring more than 10 guests at one time must obtain permission from the Pool Manager at least 48 hours in advance.
