Friendly Reminder Concerning **Design Review Board Rules & Regulations**

- Applications are required to be submitted before starting most work concerning changes to the outside of your house and property. Applications can be found on our website listed above. Use drop slot at the barn to submit. The Board reviews weekly.
- Lawns must be regularly cut and maintained at a reasonable height. Weed whacking needs to be kept up. Flower beds need to be maintained. Bushes need to be kept trimmed at reasonable heights. Weeds/grass growing in cracks in driveways/sidewalk areas need to be removed.
